and chancery judges are authorized to be reimbursed for those travel expenses
at the rate as authorized for state employees and for mileage at the rate
established in the state travel regulations for state employees while
traveling within the state from in the performance of
their official duties."
    SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
