12 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND FOR
13 OTHER PURPOSES."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - SCHOOL FOR MATH AND SCIENCE. There is
24 hereby established for the Department of Education - General Education
25 Division - School for Math and Science for the 1997-99 biennium, the following
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
30 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
31 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
32 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
33 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
34 successor.

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Maximum Annual

1 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education
 2 Division - School For Math And Science to be payable from the Public School
 3 Fund, solely from monies transferred from the Educational Excellence Trust
 4 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of
 5 Education - General Education Division - School for Math and Science for the
 6 biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

21 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 22 this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 23 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 24 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 25 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
 26 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 27 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 28 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 29 with in disbursement of said funds.

31 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that
 32 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in
 33 this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was
 34 adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and
 35 Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the

1 Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 2 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 3 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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6 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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10 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
 11 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 12 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
 13 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
 14 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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16 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 17 this Act are hereby repealed.

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19 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 20 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
 21 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
 22 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 24 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 25 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
 26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.

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
