2 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the 3 Department of Education - School for the Blind for the 1997-99 biennium, the 4 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as 5 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: 6 twelve (12) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not 7 to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, 8 or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

11 reasonable rules and regulations to implement the Braille and Large Print
12 Textbooks appropriation and is hereby authorized to negotiate directly with

         SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who,
17 in addition to working during the regular school term, also work during summer
18 months shall be authorized as additional compensation an amount not to exceed
19 1/12 of their annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such
20 additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary

         SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Upon the superintendent's certification
30 to the State Personnel Administrator of prior service at an educational
31 institution and most recent contractual salary, the salary of teachers holding
32 certification in teaching the visually impaired and entering state service as
33 teachers for the sensory impaired may be adjusted to a rate of pay closest to
34 but not less than their most recent annual salary.
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SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval from 2 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer appropriation from Item No. (08) Summer School, in Section 3 of this Act, to Item No. (01) Regular Salaries and to Item No. (03) Personal Services 5 Matching, in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate Teachers, Houseparents, Food Service and Nursing staff who work during the summer school term and to compensate coaches and organization sponsors as referenced in Section 11 of this Act. 9 10 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Schools 11 for the Deaf and Blind may make special allowances available to any employee who performs one of the following duties in addition to their normal duties: 13 1) Teaching adult education classes on weekends or evenings 2) Coaching one or more sports 14 3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours 15 16 outside of the normal working day. 17 Compensation for additional duties may not exceed \$3,000 per school term for any one employee during each fiscal year. 19 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. No employee drawing a salary or other 2.0 form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind shall be 22 paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other than 23 reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State that 26 the work performed by the employee for the other position does not interfere 27 with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the higher authorized maximum annual salary. 30 Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall be 31 32 subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by any 33 agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less than 34 three (3) years or until such employee shall repay to the State of Arkansas 35 any sums received by such employee in violation of this section, together with

1 interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum. 2 3 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. POOL POSITIONS. The Department of 4 Education - School for the Blind, may establish and maintain for the 1997-99 5 biennium a pool of fifty (50) classified positions not to exceed the maximum 6 grade of 24. These positions are to be used if necessary in the event the School for the Blind reorganizes during the 1997-99 biennium and the personnel services needs of the School as authorized in Section 1 herein do not meet the 9 needs of such reorganization. To obtain a position from the pool, the School 10 for the Blind must surrender the position being reclassified. No 11 classification, grade, or salary level will be assigned to the pool positions 12 until such time as specific positions are requested by the School for the 13 Blind and approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after receiving 14 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 15 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 16 17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 22 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 23 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 2.5 26 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 28 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 29 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34 35 SECTION 16. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and

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1 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
 2 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
         SECTION 17. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
 4
 5 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
 6 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
 7 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
 8 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
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10
         SECTION 18. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
11 with this Act are hereby repealed.
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         SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
14 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
15 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
16 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
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
