23 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Juvenile participants in the Arkansas

- 24 National Guard Youth Challenge Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving
- 25 services from the Arkansas National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary

Transportation to support Arkansas 12 National Guard Youth Challenge Program activities for juvenile participants 13 and staff may be provided by commercial lease/purchase of motor vehicles not 14 to exceed six vehicles. 15 SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 16 17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 22 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 23 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 2.5 26 SECTION 26.          SECTION 30. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
14 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
15 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
16 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
