18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-11-430(a) is amended to read as follows:

21 "(a) Whenever an active or retired police officer shall die or be
22 killed, the board of trustees shall appropriate from the fund a sum of not
23 less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than ~~two thousand dollars~~
24 ~~(\$2,000)~~ four thousand dollars (\$4,000) to pay the funeral expenses of the
25 decedent."

26
27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30
31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35 act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.
