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3 SECTION 2. Arkansas code 8-9-201(d), pertaining to the State Marketing 4 Board for Recyclables, is amended to read as follows:

5 "(d) Members shall serve without compensation but shall be entitled to

6 per diem and mileage allowances for attendance at council meetings at the same

7 rate authorized by law for legislators' attendance at meetings of joint

8 interim committees of the General Assembly. Members shall be entitled to

9 reimbursement for actual expenses incurred for lodging while attending council

10 meetings which involve overnight stays. may receive expense reimbursement and

11 stipends in accordance with 8 25-16-901, et seq."

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- 13 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 17-24-201 (a) concerning the State Board of 14 Collection Agencies, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 '(a) There is created a State Board of Collection Agencies composed of
- 16 four (4) members to be appointed by the Governor, which members shall serve
- 17 three-year terms without compensation except for travel expenses incurred in
- 18 connection with the activities of the board they may receive expense
- 19 reimbursement and stipends in accordance with 25-16-901 et seq.'

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- 21 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 25-16-903, which allows listed state boards to 22 receive a stipend of fifty dollars (\$50), is amended to add the following new
- 23 subdivision to make the State Board of Collection Agencies eligible to receive
- 24 a stipend:
- 25 "(67) State Board of Collection Agencies.'"

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- 27 SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 31 SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 35 act are declared to be severable.

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1	SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2	hereby repealed.
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4	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
5	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Arkansas Code 25-16-903 authorized
6	members of the Advisory Committee on Petroleum Storage Tanks and members of
7	the State Marketing Board of Recyclables to receive a stipend for attending
8	board meetings; that Arkansas Code 8-7-904 and 8-9-201 were enacted prior to
9	Arkansas Code 25-16-903 and do not mention stipends; that the earlier code
10	sections should be amended to parallel the authority granted in $^{\rm \$}$ 25-16-903;
11	that this act makes those technical corrections; and that this act should go
12	into effect as soon as possible in order to avoid confusion. It is further
13	found and determined by the General Assembly that the current law concerning
14	expense reimbursement for the State Board of Collection Agencies does not
15	conform to Arkansas Code 25-16-901 et seq.; the State Board of Collection
16	Agencies should be allowed to receive a stipend; and that this act is
17	immediately necessary for the effective operation of the State Board of
18	Collection Agencies. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this act
19	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor.
21	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
22	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
23	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
24	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the
25	veto.
