19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-36-204 (b) is amended to read as follows:

22 (b) Every motorcycle and every motor-driven cycle upon a street or
23 highway within this state at any time shall display lighted lamps and
24 illuminating devices as respectively required for different classes of
25 vehicles, subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles as stated.
26 During the period between sunrise and ending at sunset, the headlamp displayed
27 by a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle may use either a continuous beam or an
28 pulsating beam. ↘
29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
