17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-54-111 is amended to read as follows:

20 "§ 5-54-111. Second degree escape.

21 (a) A person commits the offense of second degree escape if:

22 (1) He uses or threatens to use physical force in escaping from
23 custody; or

24 (2) Having been found guilty of ~~a felony~~ any crime, he escapes
25 from custody; or

26 (3) He escapes from a correctional facility.

27 (b) Second degree escape is a Class D felony."
28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
