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18	SECTION 1. As used in this act, "Health insurance po	licy" means a	group	
19	insurance policy, contract or plan or an individual policy, contract or plan			
20	which provides medical coverage on an expense incurred, service, or prepaid			
21	risk-sharing basis. The term includes, but is not limited to, a policy,			
22	contract, or plan issued by an entity subject to any of the	following law	<u>s:</u>	
23	(1) the Arkansas Insurance Code, A.C.A. 23-60-101, e	t seq.;		
24	(2) A.C.A. 23-74-101, et seq. relating to fraternal	benefit societ	ies;

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35	SECTION 2. (a) No health insurance policy shall pro	vide an incent	ive,	
36	directly or indirectly, to a physician or physician group a	s an inducemen	t to:	

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1	(1) Reduce or limit medically necessary services provided with		
2	respect to a patient.		
3	(2) Limit information provide by a physician to a patient		
4	concerning the patient \blacksquare s condition, treatment options, or the possible		
5	consequences of treatment options.		
6	(3) Reduce or limit referrals made by the physician to a		
7	specialist.		
8	(b) A health insurance policy that violates this section shall be		
9	subject to a civil penalty of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per		
10	violation, after notice and hearing before the Insurance Commissioner.		
11			
12	SECTION 3. Health insurance policy providing coverage for a mastectomy		
13	shall provide, as part of the minimum benefits, coverage for a minimum		
14	hospital stay of forty-eight (48) hours.		
15			
16	SECTION 4. Health insurance policy providing coverage for obstetrical		
17	care shall provide, as part of the minimum benefits, coverage for forty-eight		
18	(48) hours hospital stay after childbirth.		
19			
20	SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
21	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
22	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.		
23			
24	SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
25	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
26	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
27	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
28	act are declared to be severable.		
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30	SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
31	hereby repealed.
