For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING BODY OF CITIES OF THE
10 SECOND CLASS AND INCORPORATED TOWNS TO PROVIDE BY
11 ORDINANCE FOR EXPENDITURES NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND
12 DOLLARS (\$1,000) ANNUALLY FOR INCIDENTALS FOR EMPLOYEES
13 AND OTHER INDIVIDUALS PROVIDING SERVICES DIRECTLY OR
14 INDIRECTLY FOR THE CITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "TO AUTHORIZE CITIES OF THE SECOND CLASS
17 AND INCORPORATED TOWNS TO PROVIDE BY
18 ORDINANCE FOR EXPENDING UP TO ONE
19 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) ANNUALLY FOR
20 INCIDENTALS FOR EMPLOYEES AND OTHER

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. The governing body of every second class city and
27 incorporated town may by ordinance authorize the expenditure of city funds in
28 an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per year for incidentals
29 for employees or other individuals providing services directly or indirectly
30 for the city. Such incidentals include, but are not limited to, expenditures
31 for visiting dignitaries and officials, to boost morals, and to express
32 sympathy or concern for employees or citizens of the city. The ordinances
33 shall be valid only for the fiscal year during which enacted.

34
35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
