27	incorporated town may by ordinance authorize the expenditure	of city funds	s in
28	an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per year	ar for incider	ntals
29	for employees or other individuals providing services direct	ly or indirect	tly
30	for the city. Such incidentals include, but are not limited	to, expenditu	ures
31	for visiting dignitaries and officials, to boost morals, and to express		
32	sympathy or concern for employees or citizens of the city. The ordinances		
33	shall be valid only for the fiscal year during which enacted	<u>.</u>

35	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and	d permanent na	ature
36	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the	- Arkansas Cod	de

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 7 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 10 hereby repealed.
