19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-64-201 is amended to read as follows:

21	(a) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas shall consist				
	of ten (10) mem				
23	(b) The Governor shall appoint the trustee. These appointments shall				
	be with the consent of the Senate, except as provided in Arkansas				
	Constitution, Amendment 33, Section 5.				
26	(c)(1)(A) One (1) member shall be appointed from each of the seven (7)				
27	congressional districts in the state, and three (3) two (2) members shall be

- 14 (2) The student member shall have all the privileges and rights
- 15 of other board members and shall receive the same stipend, travel, and other
- 16 expenses as other members of the board.
- 17  $\frac{(e)}{(f)}$  The trustees shall make and subscribe to an affidavit before
- 18 entering upon their respective duties to faithfully, diligently, and

- 8 " $^{\circ}$  6-67-102. Board of trustees.
- 9 (a) There is created an honorary board constituting the Board of
- 10 Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas, which is made and constituted
- 11 a body politic and corporate.
- 12 (b)(1) The board shall consist of seven (7) members.
- 13 (2) The Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,
- 14 shall appoint the members of the board.
- 15 (3) The Secretary of State shall furnish a certificate to each board
- 16 member within ten (10) days following appointment, whereupon the appointee
- 17 shall notify the Governor and the Secretary of State in writing of his
- 18 acceptance of such appointment within thirty (30) days, and if such appointee
- 19 shall fail to give such notice of his acceptance within the time required,
- 20 then the appointment shall be declared void and another appointment shall be
- 21 made.
- 22 (c)(1) Members of the board appointed by the Governor under the
- 23 provisions of this section, in addition to possessing the qualifications of an
- 24 elector, shall reside in the State of Arkansas.
- 25 (2)(A) The Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, Auditor
- 26 of State, Treasurer of State, Commissioner of State Lands, Justices of the
- 27 Supreme Court, and the director or employees of any state department, state
- 28 agency, or state institution shall be ineligible for membership on the board
- 29 provided for in this section during the time for which he was elected or
- 30 appointed.
- 31 (B) No individual may be a member of more than one (1) of the
- 32 boards created under the provisions of  $^{\circ}$  25-17-201 at the same time.
- 33 (d)(1) The term of office for each member shall commence on January 15
- 34 and shall end on January 14 of the seventh year following the year in which
- 35 the regular term commenced.
- 36 (2) The Governor shall submit to the Senate for approval, on or

- 1 before the fourteenth day following the commencement of each regular session
- 2 of the General Assembly, the names of all unconfirmed appointments made by him
- 3 to fill expired terms and the names of appointments to fill the terms expiring
- 4 during the regular session of the General Assembly. The members appointed by
- 5 the Governor to fill vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of
- 6 members may qualify and hold office until the appointments are rejected by the
- 7 Senate.
- 8 (3) Upon the expiration of the term immediately following the passage
- 9 of this act of a board member, the vacancy shall be filled by a student
- 10 member.
- 11 (e) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the board for any reason
- 12 other than the expiration of the regular terms for which the members were
- 13 appointed shall be filled by the appointment of the Governor, subject to the
- 14 approval by a majority of the remaining members of the board, and shall be
- 15 thereafter effective until the expiration of the regular terms.
- 16 (f)(1) Before entering upon his respective duties, each board member
- 17 shall take and subscribe, and file in the office of the Secretary of State, an
- 18 oath to support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of
- 19 the State of Arkansas and to faithfully perform the duties of the office upon
- 20 which he is about to enter, and that he will not be or become interested,
- 21 directly or indirectly, in any contract made by the board.
- 22 (2)(A) Any violation of the oath shall be a misdemeanor and shall be
- 23 punished by a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by
- 24 imprisonment of not less than six (6) months, or by both fine and
- 25 imprisonment.
- 26 (B) Any contract entered into in violation of the oath shall be
- 27 null and void.
- 28 (g)(1)(A) There shall be one (1) regular meeting of the board each
- 29 year, to be held within thirty (30) days after the close of commencement week.
- 30 (B) Called meetings may be held at the request of the president
- 31 or of any two (2) members of the board if at least seven (7) days' written
- 32 notice is given, in advance, to each member of the called meeting, except in
- 33 cases of emergency, when three (3) days' notice is sufficient.
- 34 (2) The board shall elect from its members a chairman who shall
- 35 preside at the meetings of the board, a vice chairman who shall preside at the
- 36 meetings of the board in the absence of the regular chairman, and a secretary

 $1\,$  who shall keep the records of the meetings of the board. The secretary need

- 2 not be a member of the board.
- 3 (3) A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum.
- 4 (4) Members of the board provided for in this section shall be
- 5 entitled to their actual expenses of attending meetings.
- (h)(1) The Governor shall have the power to remove any member of the
- 7 board before the expiration of his term for cause only, after notice and
- 8 hearing.
- 9 (2) The removal shall become effective only when approved in writing
- 10 by a majority of the total number of the board, but the member removed or his
- 11 successor shall have no right to vote on the question of removal.
- 12 (3) The removal action shall be filed with the Secretary of State
- 13 together with a complete record of the proceedings at the hearing.
- 14 (4)(A) An appeal may be taken to the Pulaski County Circuit Court by
- 15 the Governor or the member ordered removed, and the appeal shall be tried de
- 16 novo on the record of the hearing before the Governor.
- 17 (B) An appeal may be taken from the circuit court to the Supreme
- 18 Court, which shall likewise be tried de novo.
- 19 (i)(1) The student member who is appointed to the board shall be a
- 20 full-time, junior or senior undergraduate student at the University of Central
- 21 Arkansas and shall be a resident of this state.
- 22 (A) If at any time during the term of office the student member
- 23 ceases to be a full-time undergraduate student or fails to maintain
- 24 satisfactory academic progress, the membership of the student on the board
- 25 shall be terminated and the office of the student member shall be deemed
- 26 vacant.
- 27 (2) The student member shall have all the privileges and rights of
- 28 other board members and shall receive the same stipend, travel, and other
- 29 expenses as other members of the board."

- 31 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 35 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 3 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 6 hereby repealed. /s/Rep. Judy Smith
