9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-16-106 PERTAINING TO THE
10 SALE OF SURPLUS COUNTY PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-16-106
14 PERTAINING TO THE SALE OF SURPLUS COUNTY
15 PROPERTY."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-16-106 is amended to read as follows:

20 "§ 14-16-106. Sale of surplus ~~personalty~~ property.

21 (a) If it is determined by the county judge to be surplus, any personal
22 or real property owned by a county may be sold at public auction to the
23 highest bidder.

24 (b)(1) Notice of the public auction shall be published at least once a
25 week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation
26 in the county.

27 (2) The notice shall specify the description of the property to
28 be sold and the time and place of the public auction."

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
