9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 25-18-223 (a), TO REQUIRE
10 THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PUBLISH A BOUND BOOK REPORT
11 CONTAINING HISTORICAL AND CONTEMPORARY INFORMATION AND
12 SUBJECT MATTER TAKEN FROM THE RECORDS AND ARCHIVES OF THE
13 SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE SECRETARY OF
17 STATE TO PUBLISH A BOUND BOOK REPORT
18 CONTAINING HISTORICAL AND CONTEMPORARY
19 INFORMATION."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-18-223 (a), concerning the bound book
24 report of the Secretary of State, is amended to read as follows:

25 (a)(1) The Secretary of State is directed to cause to be compiled,
26 edited, and published a bound book report of the Secretary of State for the
27 period ending December 31, ~~1985~~ 1997, and containing the same information and
28 subject matter as the earlier biennial reports of the Secretary of State and
29 other data, both historical and contemporary, that in the opinion of the
30 Secretary of State would be of interest to all citizens of Arkansas.

31 (2) The book shall be printed ~~by offset process~~ under the proper
32 contract for state printing.
33

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
