19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated $^{\circ}$ 3-4-701 is amende	d to read as	
20	follows:		
21	"3-4-701. Creation - Issuance - Expiration.		
22	(a) In addition to all other existing alcoholic beverage permits		
23	authorized to be issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for the		
24	retail sale of alcoholic beverages, there is hereby created a post exchange		
25	package permit which shall authorize the sales of spirituous	, vinous, and	
26	malt beverages, light wine, light beer, premixed spirituous l	iquor, and li	ight
27	spirituous liquor, and Arkansas native wine, as such beverages are defined by		
28	this title, at $\frac{1}{2}$ post exchange $\frac{1}{2}$ facilities located $\frac{1}{2}$	Camp Robinso	<u>on</u>
29	and Fort Chaffee upon property owned or controlled by the Sta	te of Arkansa	as
30	and operated by and under the exclusive control of the Milita	ry Department	c of
31	Arkansas. The permit created herein shall not be subject to a	ny quota	
32	restrictions.		
33	(b) The permits authorized in this section shall be is	sued by the	
34	lcoholic Beverage Control Division to qualified persons whose application for		
35	the permit shall be accompanied by a letter of authorization signed by the		
36	Adjutant General for the State of Arkansas.		

(c) The Each permit shall be issued annually for a fee of one hundred 2 dollars (\$100) and shall expire on June 30 of each and every year." SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 12 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 15 hereby repealed. 2.8
