22	SECTION 1.	Arkansas Code 24-5-116 is amended to rea	ad as follows:

- 2 (b)(1) If a retired member with a straight life annuity dies before he
- 3 has been paid benefits equivalent to his contributions to the Arkansas State
- 4 Highway Employees' Retirement System, the difference between the benefits
- 5 received and his contributions while an active member of the system, together
- 6 with any other balance to his credit in the system, shall be paid to his
- 7 designated beneficiary.
- 8 (2) In the event there is no designated beneficiary, refund of
- 9 the unpaid balance shall be paid to his estate.
- 10 (3)(A) Payment of the refund shall be made in full or in
- 11 installments, as determined by the board.
- 12 (B) The benefits may be paid directly to a curator or
- 13 guardian, to an administrator or administratrix, or to an executor or
- 14 executrix authorized to receive such payments, wherever such representative
- 15 may be, without the appointment of a representative in this state.
- 16 (c) The Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System shall
- 17 provide life insurance in the amount of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for
- 18 the benefit of each of its members. The insurance shall remain in force
- 19 during the life of each member until his or her retirement and shall be paid
- 20 for by the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System. The System may
- 21 offer a similar or lesser amount of life insurance coverage on the lives of
- 22 the member's spouse and his dependents with the member bearing the costs of
- 23 any additional coverage."

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- 25 SECTION 2. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
- 26 implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement systems
- 27 unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year
- 28 amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
- 29 implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial
- 30 accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years
- 31 until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than
- 32 the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code 66 24-1-101, et seq.

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- 34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
- 35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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2	SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to		
3	any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect		
4	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
5	the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
6	act are declared to be severable.		
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8	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
9	hereby repealed.		
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11	SECTION 6. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the		
12	Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the State Highway		
13	Employees' Retirement System was created to benefit the employees of the		
14	Arkansas Highway Department; that, in the event of a member's death, the		
15	financial interests of the member's spouse and his dependents are often		
16	adversely affected and left in crisis; and it is immediately necessary to fill		
17	in this financial gap in the best interest of the member-employees and the		
18	State. Therefore, in the best interest of the State, an emergency is hereby		
19	declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation		
20	of the public peace, health, and safety, shall become effective on the date of		
21	its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved or vetoed by		
22	the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of		
23	time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by		
24	the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date		
25	the last house overrides the veto.
