20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:		
21			
22	SECTION 1. (a)(1) All commercial motor vehicles equipped with an open		
23	bed and hauling or carrying any load of gravel, rock, or asphalt which may		
24	reasonably be expected to become dislodged or fall from the vehicle as a		
25	result of wind pressure or air pressure or by movement	of the vehicle shall	
26	have a protective cover over the load or shall sufficie	ntly secure the load	so
27	that no portion of the gravel, rock, or asphalt can become dislodged or fall		
28	from the vehicle while being hauled or carried over the public highways of		
29	Arkansas.		
30	(2) A vehicle not equipped with a protecti	ve cover shall comply	
31	with this section by January 1, 1998. A vehicle equipped with a protective		
32	cover shall comply with this section beginning on the effective date of this		
33	act.		
34	(3) This section shall not apply to county vehicles unless the		
35	quorum court of the county adopts an ordinance to make county vehicles subject		
36	to the requirements of subdivision (a)(1).		

1	(b) Any person who pleads guilty, nolo contendere, or is found guilty		
2	of operating a commercial motor vehicle in violation of this section shall be		
3	guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars		
4	(\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00).		
5			
6	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
7	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
8	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.		
9			
10	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
11	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
12	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
13	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
14	act are declared to be severable.		
15			
16	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
17	hereby repealed.
