- 15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 17 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
- 18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
- 19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 20 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 21 act are declared to be severable.

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- 23 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 24 hereby repealed.
