10 CAPITOL BUILDING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN CERTAIN AREAS OF
14 THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Any person smoking any cigarette, cigar, pipe, or other
19 tobacco product in the Rotunda of the State Capitol Building, or in the
20 Governor's Conference Room, the Old Supreme Court Room, or the cafeteria in
21 the State Capitol Building shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a
22 fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

24 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
25 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
26 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
30 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
32 act are declared to be severable.

34 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
35 hereby repealed.
