1 (2) Defacing objects of public respect is a Class D felony if the 2 value of repairing or replacing the damaged objects exceeds five hundred 3 dollars (\$500), but does not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars 4 (\$2,500). 5 (3) Defacing objects of public respect is a Class D felony if the 6 object is a burial monument. -(3)(4) Defacing objects of public respect is a Class C felony if 7 -8 the value of repairing or replacing the damaged objects exceeds two thousand 9 five hundred dollars (\$2,500). 10 11 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 12 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 13 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 14 15 SECTION 3.
