21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. An individual or a child with Irlen Syndrome shall be
24 considered an individual or a child with a disability for purposes of Title 6
25 of the Arkansas Code Annotated, pertaining to education, and for purposes of
26 the Arkansas Civil Rights Act, Arkansas Code Annotated §§ 16-123-101, et seq.

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
36 act are declared to be severable.
