22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the				
25	Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable				
26	from the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Guarantee Fund, for the purpose of				
27	protecting members of underfunded Arkansas municipal fire and police relief				
28	and pension funds, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the

35	SECTION 2. FUNDING TRANSFER. On or before June 15 of each fiscal year,				
36	the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board shall certify to the Chief

- 1 Fiscal Officer of the State the amount of funding it recommends for
- 2 disbursement in the ensuing fiscal year to underfunded municipal fire and
- 3 police relief and pension plans as defined in Arkansas Code  $^{\circ}24$ -11-209. The
- 4 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then immediately transfer on his books
- 5 and those of the State Treasurer amounts not to exceed the total amount
- 6 recommended by the Board or the amount appropriated herein for the ensuing
- 7 fiscal Year, whichever is the lesser amount, from the Revenue Holding Fund
- 8 Account to the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Guarantee Fund for
- 9 distribution to the recommended underfunded plans.

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- 11 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Funds distributed to underfunded local
- 12 pension programs through this appropriation shall not be used to enhance
- 13 benefits of the recipients.

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- 15 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 16 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 18 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
- 21 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
- 22 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 25 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 27 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
- 28 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
- 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
- 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
- 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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- 34 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
- 35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 2 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 3 4 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 5 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 6 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 7 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 8 9 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 10 with this Act are hereby repealed. 11 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 12 13 Eighty-First General Assembly, that certain municipal fire and police relief and pension plans are underfunded and in need of additional financial 15 assistance to maintain solvency; that the provisions of this Act will provide 16 the necessary resources for the Department of Finance and Administration to 17 assist the underfunded plans recommended by the Arkansas Fire and Police 18 Pension Review Board; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could 19 work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 20 essential governmental programs.
