BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
    SECTION 1. Every county and every first and second class city in this
state shall annually identify blighted areas within their jurisdiction and
prepare the budget for the next fiscal year in such manner that the blighted
areas shall receive priority in the expenditures of public funds so as to
revitalize the blighted areas. Special emphasis shall be placed upon the
repair, refurbishment and construction of streets, sewers, and street lights;
the prevention and containment of rodent infestation and unchecked vegetation
growth; and the identification of ownership of abandoned property.
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
