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2	SECTION 3. The Department of Arkansas State Police may utilize private
3	sector contractors to fulfill the Departments duty of inspecting motor
4	vehicle inspection stations.

6	SECTION 4. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
7	may utilize monies appropriated for miscellaneous tax refunds as a revenue
8	source for the purchase of bonds or other evidence of indebtedness secured by
