CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 10 11 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 12 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 14 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 15 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 16 17 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 18 with this Act are hereby repealed. 19 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 20 21 Eighty-First General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for 22 the operations of the Department of Education - General Education Division 23 are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of 24 Education - General Education Division to continue to provide essential 25 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the 26 necessary monies for the Department of Education - General Education Division 27 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 28 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 29 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 30 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the 31 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and 32 after the date of its passage and approval. 33
