9 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF VISUAL INVASION
10 OF PRIVACY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF
14 VISUAL INVASION OF PRIVACY"

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. (a) A person commits the crime of visual invasion of
19 privacy if he knowingly views, photographs, or films another person without
20 that persons knowledge and consent in a place where the person would have
21 reasonable expectation of privacy.

22 (b) Invasion of privacy is a Class A misdemeanor, unless committed by a
23 person who has previously been convicted of invasion of privacy, in which case
24 it is a Class D felony.

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
