24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated $^{\circ}$ 6-18-102 is amende	ed to read as	
25	follows:		
26	"6-18-102. Legislative findings Uniform dress code.		
27	(a) The General Assembly hereby finds and determines t	hat the cloth	nes
28	and footwear worn by students in the public schools often pre	occupy and	
29	distract students from their major purpose for being in school	l, that of	
30	becoming educated in math, science, English, history, and oth	er subjects.	The
31	General Assembly further finds that student competition over	clothes and	
32	footwear has, in several instances, led to violence and injur	ies during so	chool
33	hours; whereas, in those Arkansas schools that have adopted a	uniform dres	ss
34	code, disparities in student socioeconomic levels are less ob	vious, and	
35	disruptive incidents are less likely to occur.		
36	(b)(1) The board of directors of a local school distri	ct may create	an e

- 1 advisory committee composed of parents and students for the purpose of
- 2 considering shall refer consideration of whether the district should adopt a
- 3 uniform dress code for students to the districts committee on personnel
- 4 policies established under A.C.A. ⁸ 6-17-203, which, for this limited purpose,
- 5 shall include as voting members five (5) parents and five (5) students
- 6 appointed by the district board of directors.
- 7 (2) If the advisory such committee on personnel policies
- 8 recommends to the board that a uniform dress code for students be adopted, the
- 9 board may refer the issue of a dress code to the qualified electors of the
- 10 district at any school election.
- 11 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed as requiring the board
- 12 of directors of a local school district to adopt a uniform dress code or to
- 13 hold an election on the issue."

- 15 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 16 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 17 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 23 act are declared to be severable.

- 25 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 26 hereby repealed.
