26	(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall				
27	provide for and issue special ®Support the Arts in Arkansas license plates				
28	for motor vehicles. The design commemorating *Support the Arts in Arkansas				
29	for the special license plate shall be designed by a committee appointed by a				
30	institution of higher education located in Crittenden County subject to

- 2 (a) Any motor vehicle owner may apply annually to the Department of
- 3 Finance and Administration for the special license plate.
- 4 (b) The special [®]Support the Arts in Arkansas [™] license plate shall
- 5 comply with all other state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and
- 6 licensing of motor vehicles.
- 7 (c) The special *Support the Arts in Arkansas** license plates issued

- 33 <u>license plate program are supplementary and shall not be considered or used as</u>
- 34 income for purposes of reducing the general revenue appropriation to the

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SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 9 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 12 hereby repealed. /s/Rep. Ferguson et al
