9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL MOTOR
10 VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS AND OTHER
11 CERTIFIED EDUCATORS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO PROVIDE FOR ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL
15 LICENSE PLATES FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS AND
16 OTHER CERTIFIED EDUCATORS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19
20 SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
21 shall annually cause to be prepared special vehicle registration plates to be
22 issued to certified school teachers and other certified school personnel who
23 apply therefor. The design of the special plates shall be approved by the
24 State Board of Education, the Director of the Arkansas Education Association,
25 and the Director of the Arkansas Rural Education Association, with the
26 concurrence of the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration.

27
28 SECTION 2. Any resident certified school teacher or school
29 administrator may make application for and receive special vehicle
30 registration plates for personal passenger vehicles, including Class I trucks
31 and vans, owned by the applicant. The fee for each special plate shall be the
32 regular registration fee for the vehicle registered plus fifteen dollars
33 (\$15.00) for the initial issuance to cover the cost of preparing the special
34 plate. Thereafter renewal of the registration shall require only payment of
35 the regular fee for registering the vehicle.

1 SECTION 3. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
2 is authorized to adopt reasonable rules regarding proof of eligibility of
3 applicants for the special vehicle registration plates provided for herein.
4

5 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
8

9 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.
14

15 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
