## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE PLUMBERS LICENSING LAW; AND FOR OTHER  
10 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE PLUMBERS LICENSING  
14 LAW."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-38-302 is amended to read as follows:

19 "§ 17-38-302. Exemptions.

20 The licensing provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:

21 (1) Plumbing work done by a property owner in a building owned and  
22 occupied by him as his home, except where the license is required by local  
23 ordinance; or

24 (2) Work done on buildings whose primary use is agricultural located  
25 outside the incorporated limits of any city or town, unless the buildings are  
26 connected to a public water system, sewerage system, or gas utility system- ;  
27 or

28 (3) Plumbing work done by a person in residential rental property owned  
29 by the person provided that the plumbing work must meet all applicable  
30 plumbing codes."

31  
32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35  
36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
