9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 19, CHAPTER 11,
10 SUBCHAPTER 2, THE ARKANSAS PURCHASING LAW, TO PROVIDE THAT
11 COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND COMPETITIVE SEALED BIDDING APPLIES
12 TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL DEPARTMENTS; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22
23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 11, Subchapter 2 is amended
24 to add the following new section:

25 "19-11-263. Bidding procedures for exempt agencies.
26 The requirements for competitive bidding and competitive sealed bidding
27 under this subchapter shall apply to exempt agencies. Each exempt agency may
28 act on its own behalf as a purchasing agency."

29
30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33
34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
