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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:		
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated $^{\circ}$ 8-6-502 is herek	by amended by	
23	adding a definition as follows:		
24	"Illegal dumps control officer means an individual employed by a duly		
25	authorized regional solid waste management district within this state, a		
26	county government within this state, or a pollution control inspector or other		
27	authorized representative of the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and		
28	Ecology, who is empowered to insure compliance with the pro-	visions of this	<u> </u>
29	subchapter."		
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31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated Subchapter 5, Cha	pter 6, Title 8	8 is
32	hereby amended to add a new section at the end thereof to read as follows:		
33	"Enforcement Generally.		
34	(a)(1) Illegal dumps control officers are hereby empowered to insure		
35	compliance with the provisions herein by having the right and duty to inspect		
36	suspected illegal dumps, collect evidence of open dumping and present same to		

- 1 the prosecuting attorney or a court of competent jurisdiction where the
- 2 offense was committed, and issue and serve citations for violations of any
- 3 state law prohibiting the illegal dumping of solid waste with said authority
- 4 limited to violations of illegal dumping not occurring on an individual's own
- 5 property.
- 6 (2) Citations issued by illegal dumps control officers shall be
- 7 filed in any court having jurisdiction in the county where the offense is
- 8 committed.
- 9 (3) Citations may be served in person or by mailing a copy of
- 10 same, certified mail, restricted delivery, to either the address obtained from
- 11 evidence collected from the illegal dump or to the persons last known
- 12 address. Persons receiving citations shall appear before the court named
- 13 within the citation at the time designation therein.
- 14 (4) Courts having jurisdiction over citations issued by Illegal
- 15 Dumps Control Officers may issue penalties as specified in Arkansas Code
- 16 Annotated 8-6-204(a).
- 17 (b) All illegal dumps control officers shall be licensed and certified
- 18 in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated  $^{6}8-6-901$  et seq., as amended.
- 19 (c) Illegal dumps control officers shall not have powers of arrest."

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- 21 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Annotated  $^{\circ}$  8-6-901 is hereby amended by
- 22 adding a definition as follows:
- 23 "Illegal dumps control officer means an individual employed by a duly
- 24 authorized solid waste management district within this state, a county
- 25 government within this state, or a pollution control inspector or other
- 26 representative of the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology,
- 27 who is empowered to ensure compliance with any state law prohibiting the
- 28 illegal dumping of solid wastes."

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- 30 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Annotated 8 8-6-905(b)(2) is hereby amended to
- 31 read as follows:
- 32 "(2) To issue licenses to qualified solid waste management facility
- 33 operators and qualified illegal dumps control officers, to renew those
- 34 licenses, to suspend or revoke the licenses for cause, after due notice and
- 35 opportunity for hearing, and to issue one-year apprenticeship licenses to
- 36 operators-in-training; and"

As Engrossed: H3/12/97 H3/14/97 S3/27/97 1 Arkansas Code  $^{\circ}$  8-6-201 et seq.,  $^{\circ}$  8-6-501 et seq. and  $^{\circ}$  8-6-2 3 901 et seq. shall not apply to: (1) Any place at which agricultural gleanings and crop residue, 5 resulting from operations of farms, grain elevators, cotton gins and similar industries, are being land applied according to current management practices of such industries or the agricultural community and with the consent of the landowner is not an illegal dump; and 9 (2) Any landowner who disposes of solid waste on the property which 10 waste results from such agricultural or farming operations or household 11 operations and such disposal does not constitute a fire, health or safety 12 hazard to the public. 13 14 SECTION 6. None of the provisions of this act are intended to supersede 15 any of the reuse, recycling or fill provisions of state law or Regulation 22 16 of the Solid Waste Management Division of the Department of Pollution Control 17 and Ecology. 18 19 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision 21 Commission shall incorporate same in the code. 22 SECTION 8. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to 23 24 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect 25 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 26 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this 27 act are declared to be severable. 28 29 SECTION 9.
