9	SECTION 2. Any physician who seeks licensure in this state pursuant to
10	the requirements of Section 1 of this act shall, upon submission of the proper
11	credentialing documents to the board, be issued a temporary license to
12	practice medicine in this state until such time as final action is taken by
13	the board on such physician's application.
14	
15	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
16	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
17	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
20	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
21	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
22	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
23	act are declared to be severable.
