19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20
21 SECTION 1. Any person who is found by a court of law to have knowingly
22 violated any state law in conjunction with the performance or acquisition of a
23 contract with the state shall be ineligible to contract with the state for a
24 period of three (3) years.

25
26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29
30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

35
36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
