9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-14-2103 AND 27-14-2104
10 CONCERNING DRIVE-OUT TAGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "AN ACT CONCERNING DRIVE-OUT TAGS."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-14-2103 is amended to read as follows:

18 "27-14-2103. Validity period.

19 Drive-out tags shall not be valid in any event for more than ~~forty-eight~~
20 ~~(48) hours~~ fourteen (14) days."

22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-2104 is amended to read as follows:

23 "27-14-2104. Fee - Disposition.

24 (a) Drive-out tags shall be issued for a fee of ~~one dollar (\$1.00)~~ two
25 dollars (\$2.00) per tag.

26 (b) Proceeds of the sales shall be credited to the Department of
27 Arkansas State Police Fund."

29 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
