9 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COLLEGES AND
10 UNIVERSITIES TO PLACE ITEMS REQUESTED BY THE PRESIDENT
11 ELECTED BY THE STUDENT BODY OF THE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY
12 ON THE BOARD AGENDA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
16 OF COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES TO PLACE
17 ITEMS REQUESTED BY THE PRESIDENT ELECTED
18 BY THE STUDENT BODY OF THE COLLEGE OR
19 UNIVERSITY ON THE BOARD AGENDA; AND FOR
20 OTHER PURPOSES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23
24 SECTION 1. (a) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas
25 shall allow the student body president of each university in the University of
26 Arkansas system to place items concerning the student body population on the
27 board agenda.

28 (b) The board shall allow the student body president of each university
29 a reasonable amount of time to discuss the issues on the board agenda.

30
31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-65-202 is amended to read as follows:

32 "6-65-202. Powers and duties of board.

33 (a) The board created in § 6-65-201 is charged with the management and
34 control of Arkansas State University.

35 (b) The board shall have the power, authority, and duties formerly
36 conferred by law on the board it succeeds.

1 (c) The board shall allow the student body president of Arkansas State
 2 University to place items concerning the student body population on the board
 3 agenda.

4 (d) The board shall allow the student body president of Arkansas State
 5 University a reasonable amount of time to discuss the issues on the board
 6 agenda."

7

8 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 6-65-302 is amended to read as follows:

9 "6-65-302. Powers and duties of board.

10 (a) The board created in § 6-65-301 is charged with the management and
 11 control of Arkansas Tech University.

12 (b) The board shall have the power, authority, and duties formerly
 13 conferred by law on the board it succeeds.

14 (c) The board shall allow the student body president of Arkansas Tech
 15 University to place items concerning the student body population on the board
 16 agenda.

17 (d) The board shall allow the student body president of Arkansas Tech
 18 University a reasonable amount of time to discuss the issues on the board
 19 agenda."

20

21 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 6-65-402 is amended to read as follows:

22 "6-65-402. Board of trustees - Powers and duties.

23 (a) The Board of Trustees for Southern Arkansas University appointed
 24 under the provisions of § 6-65-401 is charged with the management and control
 25 of Southern Arkansas University.

26 (b) The board shall allow the student body president of Southern
 27 Arkansas University to place items concerning the student body population on
 28 the board agenda.

29 (c) The board shall allow the student body president of Southern
 30 Arkansas University a reasonable amount of time to discuss the issues on the
 31 board agenda."

32

33 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 6-66-102 is amended by adding additional
 34 subsections at the end to read as follows:

35 (e) The board shall allow the student body president of Henderson State
 36 University to place items concerning the student body population on the board

1 agenda.

2 (f) The board shall allow the student body president of Henderson State
3 University a reasonable amount of time to discuss the issues on the board
4 agenda.

5

6 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 6-67-103 is amended to by adding additional
7 subsections at the end to read as follows:

8 (e) The board shall allow the student body president of the University
9 of Central Arkansas to place items concerning the student body population on
10 the board agenda.

11 (f) The board shall allow the student body president of the University
12 of Central Arkansas a reasonable amount of time to discuss the issues on the
13 board agenda.

14

15 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
16 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
17 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

18

19 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
23 act are declared to be severable.

24

25 SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
26 hereby repealed.
