20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 1-5-107 is repealed.

23 ~~1-5-107. Confederate Flag Day.~~

24 ~~(a) The Saturday immediately preceding Easter Sunday of each year is~~
25 ~~designated as "Confederate Flag Day" in this state.~~

26 ~~(b) No person, firm, or corporation shall display any Confederate flag~~
27 ~~or replica thereof in connection with any advertisement of any commercial~~
28 ~~enterprise, or in any manner for any purpose except to honor the Confederate~~
29 ~~States of America.~~

30 ~~(c) Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this~~
31 ~~section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined~~
32 ~~not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than one thousand dollars~~
33 ~~(\$1,000).~~

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
