12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the*
22 *Bureau of Juvenile Probation Research for the 1997-99 biennium, the following*
23 *maximum number of regular employees, the grades to be assigned to the*
24 *respective positions, and the maximum annual salaries for each position. The*
25 *maximum annual salary for the positions assigned to grades shall be determined*
26 *in accordance with, but shall not exceed the maximum annual amount for the*
27 *grade assigned herein, as established in Arkansas Code Section 21-5-209. The*
28 *maximum annual salary of the Director of said agency shall not exceed the*
29 *maximum set forth herein. Except for the purpose of determining the maximum*
30 *annual salary rate, which is to be applicable to each of the positions to*
31 *which a salary grade is assigned hereinafter, in accordance with the*
32 *provisions of Arkansas Code Section 21-5-209, all positions set forth herein*
33 *shall be exempt from other provisions of the Uniform Classification and*
34 *Compensation Act or its successor, shall not be exempt from the provisions of*
35 *the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.*

15 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Bureau
 16 of Juvenile Probation Research, to be payable from the State General Services
 17 Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Bureau of
 18 Juvenile Probation Research for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the
 19 following:

33 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated
 34 to the Bureau of Juvenile Probation Research, to be payable from the federal
 35 funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for special

1 juvenile programs of the Bureau of Juvenile Probation Research for the
2 biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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8 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The Bureau of Juvenile Probation Research
9 is hereby authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations
10 authorized for Capital Outlay in Section 2 of this Act.

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12 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon seeking and
13 receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and review by
14 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of
15 the Bureau of Juvenile Probation Research is authorized to transfer
16 appropriation from any line item authorized in Section 2 of this Act to any
17 other line authorized in Section 2 of this Act.

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19 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
20 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
22 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
25 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
26 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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29 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
31 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint

1 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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3 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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7 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
9 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
10 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
11 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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13 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
14 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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16 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
17 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
18 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
19 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
24 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
