9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALL GOVERNMENTAL AND QUASI-
10 GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES WHOSE GOVERNING BODIES ARE SELF-
11 PERPETUATING SHALL HEREAFTER BE ELECTED; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "TO PROVIDE THAT ALL GOVERNMENTAL AND
16 QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES WHOSE
17 GOVERNING BODIES ARE SELF-PERPETUATING
18 SHALL HEREAFTER BE ELECTED."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21
22 SECTION 1. The governing bodies of all governmental and quasi-
23 governmental entities which have the authority to fill the vacancies in their
24 own membership shall hereafter have no authority to fill the vacancies that
25 occur in their own membership. Such vacancies shall be filled at general
26 elections by the qualified voters within the geographic boundaries over which
27 the entity has jurisdiction. Each entity shall establish procedures for the
28 implementation of this act. Actions of any person appointed in contravention
29 of this act are void.

30
31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34
35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
