19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 11-9-102(5)(A) is amended to read as follows:		
20	"(5)(A) Compensable injury means:		
21	(i) An accidental injury causing internal or external physical		
22	harm to the body or accidental injury to prosthetic appliances,		
23	including eyeglasses, contact lenses, or hearing aids, arising out of		
24	and in the course of employment and which requires medical services or		
25	results in disability or death. An injury is accidental only if it		
26	is caused by a specific incident and is identifiable by time	e and place	
27	of occurrence;		
28	(ii) An injury causing internal or external physical	harm to	
29	the body and arising out of and in the course of employment	if it is	
30	not caused by a specific incident or is not identifiable by time and		
31	place of occurrence, if the injury is: :		
32	(a) Caused by rapid repetitive motion. Carpal tunnel syndrome		
33	is specifically categorized as a compensable injury falling within		
34	this definition;		
35	(b) A back injury which is not caused by a specific incident or		
36	which is not identifiable by time and place of occurrence;

         (iii) Mental illness as set out in 8 11-9-113;

         SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
 9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.
