9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 5-73-310(8) TO
10 BE KNOWN AS THE GUN REGISTRATION ACT OF 1997 ; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "THE GUN REGISTRATION ACT OF 1997"

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-73-310(8) is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 "(8)(A) A description and the serial number of any handgun the
21 applicant may desire to carry.

22 (B) Any applicant may list up to ~~three (3)~~ five (5) handguns that
23 the applicant may choose to carry, but the applicant must establish
24 proficiency in the use of each of the handguns as required in the training
25 course prescribed herein.

26 (C)(i) In the event a license is issued pursuant to this
27 subchapter, the ~~serial number~~ caliber and type of the listed handguns shall be
28 printed only on the license.

29 (ii) All ~~other~~ records of the serial numbers shall
30 thereafter be ~~expunged~~ destroyed.

31 (D) Should a license be denied, all records of the serial numbers
32 shall be ~~expunged~~ destroyed.

33 ~~_____ (E) All records of serial numbers of listed handguns shall be~~
34 ~~destroyed when the license expires.~~

35 (E)(1) Prior to the effective date of this act, the Attorney
36 General shall promulgate regulations to ensure the identity, confidentiality,

1 and security of all records and data provided by the Arkansas State Police
2 pursuant to this section.

3 (2) The Attorney General shall conduct an annual compliance
4 inspection to ensure that records maintained pursuant to this act are timely
5 destroyed as provided for herein and shall report his findings to the Governor
6 and to the presiding officer of each house of the General Assembly."

7

8 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

11

12 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

17

18 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19 hereby repealed.
