10 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-301 TO PROVIDE FOR THE
11 SELECTION OF FIVE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE BUDGET COMMITTEE TO
12 SERVE AS EX OFFICIO NON-VOTING MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE
13 COUNCIL; TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-502 TO PROVIDE FOR
14 THE SELECTION OF FIVE HOUSE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE
15 COUNCIL TO SERVE AS EX OFFICIO NON-VOTING MEMBERS OF THE
16 JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-301 is amended by adding a new subsection
28 at the end thereof to read as follows:

29 "(h) Five (5) members of the House Budget Committee appointed by the
30 chairman of the House Budget Committee shall serve as ex officio non-voting
31 members of the Legislative Council. Such ex officio members shall be entitled
32 to per diem and mileage for attending meetings of the Legislative Council, to
33 be paid at the same rates and from the same source as regular members of the
34 Legislative Council."
35

36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-502 is amended by adding a new subsection

1 at the end thereof to read as follows:

2 "(e) Five (5) House members of the Legislative Council appointed by the
3 House chairman or House vice chairman of the Legislative Council shall serve
4 as ex officio non-voting members of the Joint Budget Committee. Such ex
5 officio members shall be entitled to per diem and mileage for attending
6 meetings of the Joint Budget Committee or separate meetings of the House
7 Budget Committee if the House Budget Committee is authorized to meet
8 separately during the interim, to be paid at the same rates and from the same
9 source as regular members of the Joint Budget Committee."

10

11 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
12 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
13 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

14

15 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
17 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19 act are declared to be severable.

20

21 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
22 hereby repealed.
