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         SECTION 1. Subsection (f) of Arkansas Code 8 7-4-101, regarding the

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1 any matter relating to campaign finance and disclosure laws, which the 2 Arkansas Ethics Commission shall have the same power and authority to enforce 3 as is provided the commission under AA 7-6-217 and 7-6-218 for the enforcement 4 of campaign finance laws; 5 (5) To develop procedures for receiving citizen complaints which 6 are referred to in subdivision (f)(4) of this section; — (6)(4) Formulate, adopt, and promulgate all necessary rules and 8 regulations to assure even and consistent application of fair and orderly 9 election procedures; and 11 with the National Voter Registration Act of 1993." 12 13 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature 14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 16 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to 17 18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect 19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 20 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this 21 act are declared to be severable. 22 23 SECTION 4.
