35	amount in excess of the maximum amount permitted by this act,	he shall for	rfeit
36	the loan advance and any charges made under the pawn transact	ion and shall	1.

1 upon surrender of the pawn ticket or receipt, return the personal property 2 deposited or pledged to secure the loan advance or shall return the property 3 purchased under the pawn transaction. If such excessive charges have been 4 paid by the depositor, pledger, or seller of the property under the pawn 5 transaction, he or she shall be entitled to recover the same, including the 6 principal, if paid, in a civil action against the pawnbroker. 7 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 8 9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 12 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 16 act are declared to be severable. 17 18 SECTION 6.
