22	2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-89-102 is amended to read as follows:	
25	5 "Å 17-89-102. Definitions.	
26	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:	
27	(1) Ophthalmic dispensing means the preparation of laboratory work	-
28	orders, verification, and dispensing of spectacle lenses, spectacles,	
29	eyeglasses, or parts thereof to the intended wearer on a written prescript	cion
30	of from a licensed physician skilled in disease of the eye or from a licensed	f
31	l optometrist.	
32	2 (A) It shall include:	
33	(i) The measuring, fitting, adapting, tinting and coating of lenses	3 <u>,</u>
34	4 and adjusting of spectacle lenses, spectacles, eyeglasses, or parts thereo	of to
35	5 the human face;	
36	(ii) The preparation and delivery of work orders to laboratory	

- 1 technicians engaged in grinding lenses and fabrication of eyewear;
- 2 (iii) The verification of the quality of finished spectacle lenses,
- 3 spectacles, or eyeglasses; and
- 4 (iv) The adjustment or repair of spectacle frames to the human face.
- 5 (B) The prescribing, adapting, fitting, duplicating, dispensing,
- 6 modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for or to the human eye is
- 7 specifically excluded;
- 8 (2) Licensed dispensing optician means any person licensed by the
- 9 Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians to engage in ophthalmic dispensing;
- 10 (3) Registered dispensing optician means any person registered by the
- 11 Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians to engage in ophthalmic dispensing;
- 12 (4) Apprentice dispensing optician means an individual registered with
- 13 the Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians to work under the supervision of a
- 14 licensed or registered dispensing optician, a physician skilled in disease of
- 15 the eye, or an optometrist licensed by this state;
- 16 (5) Supervision means the direct personal physical provision of
- 17 direction and control through personal inspection;
- 18 (6) Board means the Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians; and
- 19 (7) Person shall include individuals, partnerships, firms,
- 20 corporations, professional corporations, unincorporated associations, or any
- 21 of the foregoing."

- 23 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-89-201 is amended to read as follows:
- 24 "⁸ 17-89-201. Creation Members.
- 25 (a) There is created the Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians which
- 26 shall be responsible for administering the specific duties as set out in this
- 27 chapter.
- 28 (b) The board shall be composed of nine (9) seven (7) members appointed
- 29 by the Governor for terms of three (3) years.
- 30 (1) Three (3) members shall be practicing licensed or registered
- 31 dispensing opticians appointed by the Governor from a list of $\frac{1}{1}$ three
- 32 (3) names submitted to him by the Arkansas Association of Dispensing
- 33 Opticians. One (1) of the three (3) members shall be an employee of either an
- 34 Arkansas licensed ophthalmologist or optometrist.
- 35 (2) One (1) member shall be a member of the Arkansas State Board of
- 36 Optometry.

- 1 (3) One (1) member shall be a licensed optometrist appointed by the
- 2 Governor from a list of three (3) names submitted by the Arkansas Optometric
- 3 Association.
- 4 (4) (3) Two (2) members One (1) member shall be a licensed
- 5 ophthalmologists ophthalmologist appointed by the Governor from a list of six
- 6 (6) names submitted by the Ophthalmology Section of the Arkansas Medical
- 7 Society.
- 8 $\frac{(5)}{(4)}$ One (1) member shall be a consumer.
- 9 (6) (5) One (1) member, who shall represent the elderly, shall be sixty
- 10 (60) years of age or older, shall not be actively engaged in or retired from
- 11 the profession of ophthalmic dispensing, shall be appointed from the state at
- 12 large, subject to confirmation by the Senate, and shall be a full voting
- 13 member but shall not participate in grading examinations.
- 14 (c) The consumer board member position and the elderly representative
- 15 may not be filled by the same person.
- 16 (d) No person or employee of a person who owns or has direct or
- 17 indirect financial interest or control of a manufacturer of ophthalmic lenses
- 18 which are prescribed, delivered, sold, or dispensed in the State of Arkansas
- 19 shall serve on the board.
- 20 (e) $\frac{(1)}{}$ Terms shall begin on the first day of the fiscal year and end on
- 21 the last day of the fiscal year when the term expires.
- 22 (2) No person shall be eligible to serve more than two (2) full
- 23 consecutive terms.
- 24 (f)(1) In the event of a vacancy during a board member's term, the
- 25 Governor shall appoint a person to fill that vacancy.
- 26 (2) If the vacating member was an optician, the Governor shall make his
- 27 selection from a list of three (3) names submitted by the opticians
- 28 association.
- 29 (3) If the vacating member was an optometrist, the Governor shall make
- 30 his selection from a list of three (3) names submitted by the president of the
- 31 Arkansas State Board of Optometry.
- 32 (4) If the vacating member was an ophthalmologist, the Governor shall
- 33 make his selection from a list of three (3) names submitted by the
- 34 Ophthalmology Section of the Arkansas Medical Society.
- 35 (g) Board members may receive compensation for services in accordance
- 36 with comparable compensation paid members of other boards of the State of

- 1 Arkansas and shall receive appropriate per diem and travel expenses to the 2 extent authorized by appropriate State of Arkansas travel regulations. 3 (h) Upon the expiration of the term immediately following the passage
- 4 of this act of a board member who is a licensed optometrist, the Governor
- 5 shall not fill that vacancy.
- 6 (i) Upon the expiration of the term immediately following the passage
- 7 of this act of a board member who is a licensed ophthalmologist appointed
- 8 under subdivision 3 of subsection (b), the Governor shall not fill that
- 9 vacancy."

- 11 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 12 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 13 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 15 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 17 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 19 act are declared to be severable.

- 21 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 22 hereby repealed.
