10 MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-32-109 (a), concerning motor vehicle safety
20 inspections, is amended to read as follows:

21 (a) Every motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer
22 registered in this state, except house trailers not operated upon the
23 highways, shall be annually inspected for safety. An official certificate of
24 inspection and approval shall be obtained for each such vehicle. However, for
25 non-motorized recreational vehicles as defined by the Department of Finance
26 and Administration and which are required to be registered triennially the
27 inspection shall be a triennial inspection.
28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
