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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The General Assembly finds and
24 acknowledges that food-borne illness is a growing concern throughout the
25 United States of America. The General Assembly also finds that school age
26 children may be particularly affected by food-borne illness due to their
27 employment in "fast food" restaurants and due to preparation of food at home
28 by students who have both parents working outside of the home. The General
29 Assembly further finds that education in food-borne illness must be
30 strengthened in public schools to insure the health and safety of all
31 children.

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33 SECTION 2. (a) The Director of the General Education Division of the
34 Department of Education shall provide a clearinghouse for instructional
35 materials on food handling safety. These materials shall be developmentally
36 appropriate for students at each of the three grade clusters used in the

1 Arkansas Health Framework: K-4; 5-8; and 9-12.

2 (b) The director shall encourage collaborative efforts between the
3 Arkansas Department of Education and other agencies and/or organizations in
4 accessing developmentally appropriate instructional materials on food handling
5 safety.

6 (c) The director shall insure that any instructional materials on food
7 handling safety accessible to public schools through this clearinghouse shall
8 be in alignment with the Arkansas Health Framework in dealing with health
9 promotion and disease prevention; health information, products and services;
10 health behaviors and health risks; health-enhancing skills, and/or personal,
11 family, and community health.

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13 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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17 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21 act are declared to be severable.

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23 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24 hereby repealed.
