10 SPECIAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS TO MOVE MANUFACTURED HOME
11 UNITS WHICH ARE OVERSIZED LOADS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-35-304 is amended to read as follows:
21 "27-35-304. Special permit to move - Fee.

22 (a)(1) Manufactured home units may be lawfully moved interstate and
23 intrastate on the highways, roads, and streets of this state by procuring a
24 special permit issued by the department.

25 (2) A permit shall be required for each single continuous
26 movement of each manufactured home unit.

27 (3) No special permit shall be issued for any manufactured home
28 unit exceeding eighteen feet (18') in width inclusive of clearance lights or
29 eaves.

30 (b) Special permits required under this subchapter may be obtained from
31 any department weigh station or the central offices of the department, and the
32 department shall charge a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for the permit, provided
33 the manufactured home unit to be moved does not exceed sixteen feet (16') in
34 width ~~inclusive~~ exclusive of clearance lights or eaves.

35 (c) The department shall charge a fee of no more than one hundred fifty
36 dollars (\$150) if the manufactured home to be moved is greater than sixteen

1 feet (16') in width ~~inclusive~~ exclusive of clearance lights or eaves but does
2 not exceed eighteen feet (18') in width inclusive of clearance lights or
3 eaves."

5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8

9 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.

14

15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
