 4 of Arkansas Community College must meet a demonstrated demand of the area and
 5 industries served by the college and be designed for completion in less than
   four (4) years. After the first graduating class, baccalaureate programs that

   have a job placement rate or graduation rate of fewer than nine (9) students

 8 per year for three (3) consecutive years will be dropped. The preponderance
   of degrees offered by University of Arkansas Community College (seventy-five

10 percent (75%) or more) shall be one-semester certificates of proficiency, one-
11 year technical certificates, and two-year associate of applied science and
12 arts degrees. University of Arkansas Community College may contract with
   other colleges and universities for the offering of courses and programs.

         SECTION 4. University of Arkansas Community College shall seek a
16 systemic change in the current higher education model by realigning its
