26	five billion dollars and contribute immeasurably to the stable and well-
27	balanced economy of the state; and
28	WHEREAS, the agricultural community contributes a substantial portion of
29	the revenues which finance vital state and local services to all the states
30	citizens; and
31	WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers are deserving of public commendation and
32	appreciation,
